Over a dozen press releases will be issued in the coming weeks and during the congress, covering topics such as:

- Antibiotic resistance on the rise among periodontology patients
- Smoking impact on implant success
- Periodontitis associated with higher risk of hypertension
- Oral piercings and the dangers to periodontal health
- Oral health and its impact on sport performance
- The role of nutrition on periodontal health

The Opening Press Conference will take place on Wednesday 20 June and will provide an overall view of important topics being discussed during EuroPerio9 such as:

- The association of periodontal health with other diseases
- The burden and cost of periodontal disease
- The need for universal recognition of the profession

Over 1720 abstracts will be presented at EuroPerio9 in Amsterdam this year.
