My Conference next year is titled "Frequently Asked Questions – Unpicking Periodontal Practice." The title was intentionally broad, allowing me to draw on topics from across the full spectrum of periodontal and implant clinical practice.

This will be followed by two days of clinically relevant lectures, covering a wide range of topics — and, of course, the Conference Dinner, which promises to be a highlight of the event.
