

Postgraduate Programme in Periodontology and Implant Dentistry



Degree summary

This full-time 3-year program enables students to achieve an advanced level of knowledge, competence, and skills in Periodontology and Implant Dentistry. The Paris postgraduate programme is accredited by the European Federation of Periodontology (EFP).

The clinical training and teaching take place at the Rothschild Hospital of Paris. Research activities are conducted in several research labs of the Université Paris Cité.

→ Clinical training

During their postgraduate cursus, students treat an average 150 patients, performing more than 100 periodontal surgeries, at least 50 surgical interventions to place dental implants, and a minimum of 15 pre-implant surgeries, including guided bone regeneration and sinus floor elevations. All surgical interventions are performed under the supervision of a faculty member.

→ Research training

Each student is involved in one or more research projects in the fields of clinical, basic, or translational research in periodontology and implant dentistry. Most of the students complete the program with one or more publications in international peer-reviewed journals.
