

Management of furcation-involved teeth in patients with periodontal disease

Even though clinical research has been showing for many years that furcation-involved teeth with horizontal and vertical loss of attachment are those with the most unfavorable prognosis, a recent systematic review of the literature has shown that several therapeutic procedures, if correctly performed, are able to ensure a good long-term survival of these elements.

This scientific evidence seems to be in contrast with a very recent investigation conducted by Luigi Nibali et al. (JCP August 2021) aimed to explore how teeth with periodontal furcation involvement are managed by general dentists from Germany, Italy, United Kingdom, Sweden, Switzerland, Singapore and Australia. One third of the 400 Professionals who answered the questionnaire do not use Naber's probe. In addition, half of them (47.1%) declares to be able to make a correct diagnosis of furcation-involved molars, but less than 9% of these felt very/extremely confident at treating it.

A trend towards less interest in the possibilities of periodontal diagnosis and treatment of these teeth was found in dentists with more recent qualifications. This seems to indicate that many among the younger professionals believe that replacing molars with implants is a more reliable choice, even though more then 80% of the dentists interviewed were interested in increasing their knowledge on this matter. This Course was born from the desire to think over these clinical situations together and to provide you with those tools that will let you menage in an attentive and informed way periodontal patients with furcation-involved molars.

The Speakers who will be alternating on stage will not suggest any "competition" among the different therapeutic modalities. Instead, they will guide you through the selection of the most appropriate diagnosis, prognosis, treatment plan and support therapy for each specific clinical situation and for every patient.

Moreover, we want to share with you not only the successful cases, but also those in which there have been mistakes and complications, because we believe that awareness of our own mistakes and complications is the very essence of our own professional growth.
