General information

The programme is held in German Language. The vast majority of patients speak German. Most lectures and seminars are held in German. A **B2** level of German language competence according to the Common European Framework for Languages (CEFR; https://europass.europa.eu/en/what-common-european-framework-languages-cefr) is required.

Applications are welcome at any time. If a position is available the applicants are contacted and invited to have an interview with the director or co-director.

Practical component

- Postgraduates will have to manage and treat various periodontal cases with increasing complexity from year to year.
- Each case will be discussed and planned with the supervisor.
- Postgraduates have to provide 8 full documented clinical cases of which 5 must be presented according to the EFP Board exam.

Theoretical component

- Continuous case presentations and discussion of scientific literature among postgraduates and teaching staff
- Practical workshops (sutures, periodontal surgery in animal jaws, clinical management of patients)
- Participation in national and international congresses

Research component

- Each postgraduate will carry out an individual research project, either in basic sciences related to periodontology/implant therapy or a clinical research project. They may participate in additional research projects.
- Postgraduates will discuss and update the research project with the supervisor.
- The results of the project should be published in a peer reviewed international journal, and the project will be part of the final examination.
