Degree summary

This full-time 3-year program enables students to achieve an advanced level of knowledge, competence, and skills in Periodontology and Implant Dentistry. The Paris postgraduate program is accredited by the European Federation of Periodontology (EFP).

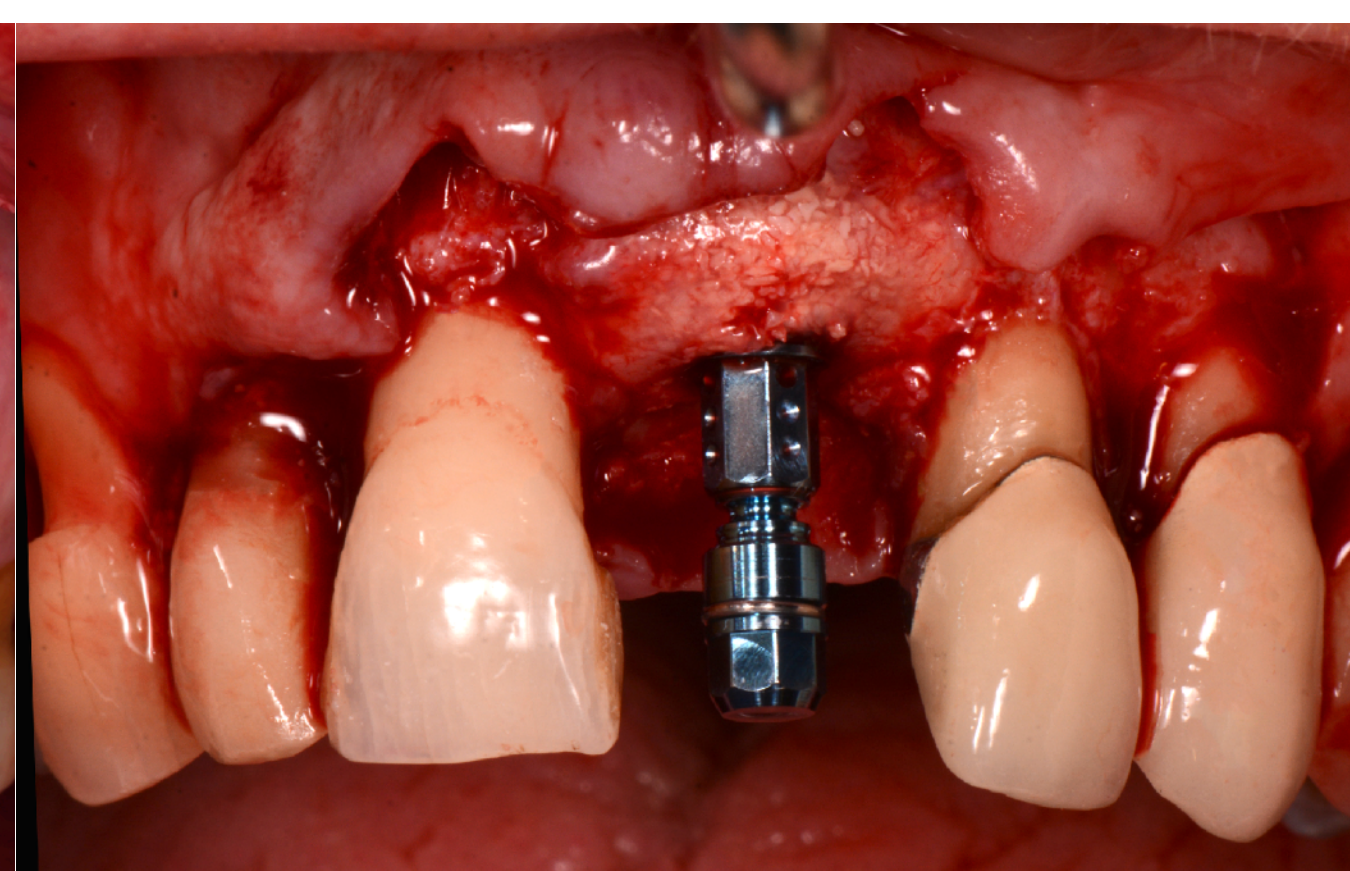
Clinical training and teaching take place at the Rothschild Hospital of Paris. Laboratory research (basic, translational or clinical) is carried out within the group of Pr. Gosset in the INSERM UMR1333 lab (Director: Pr. Chaussain) at Université Paris Cité.

Clinical training



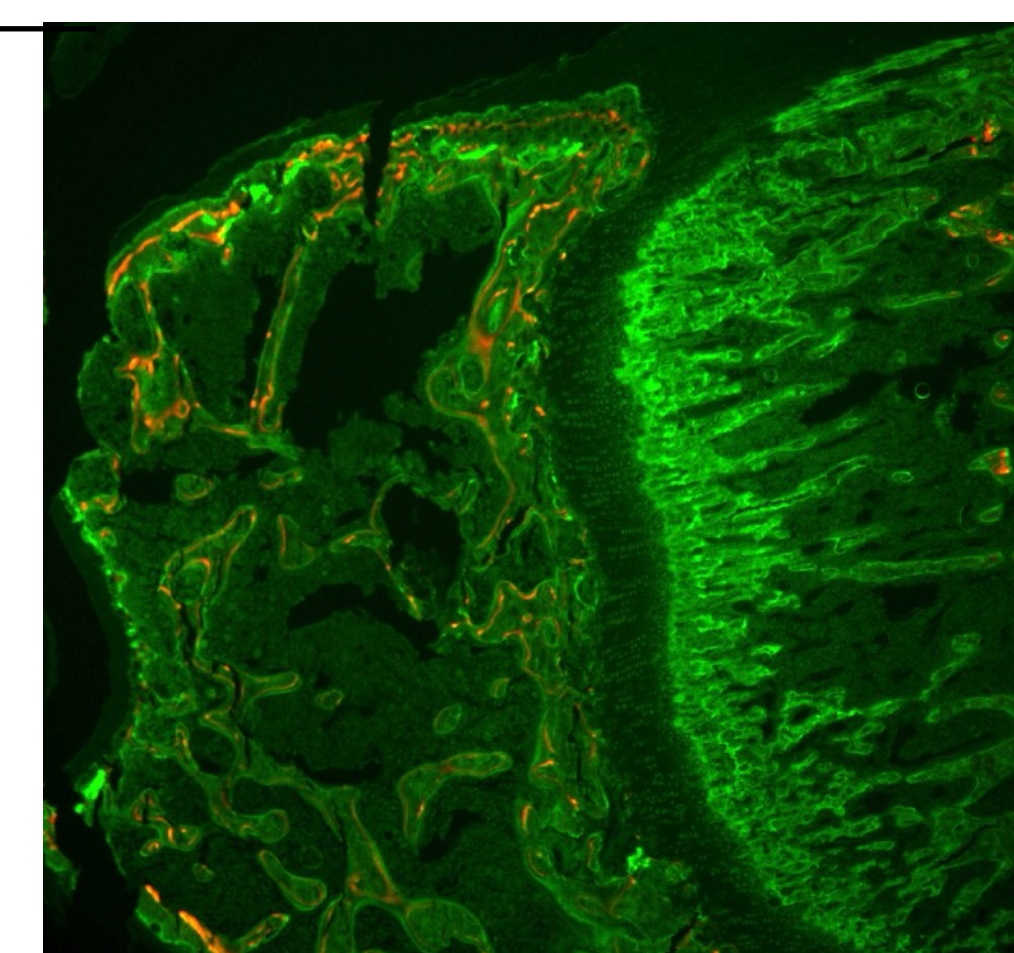
During their postgraduate program, students:

- Treat an average of 150 patients, perform over 100 periodontal surgeries (including mucogingival surgeries), place at least 50 dental implants, and complete a minimum of 15 pre-implant surgeries, including guided bone regeneration and sinus floor elevations.
- All surgical interventions are performed under the supervision of an expert clinical supervisor.



Research training

- Each student participates in at least one fundamental or clinical research in periodontology or implant dentistry.
- Each student completes the program with at least one publication in international peer-reviewed journals.

Teaching

Students: 2 to 3 per year
