

The graduate program in periodontology and implant dentistry at Strasbourg University is a 3-year full time course that is EFP accredited since 2010. The program enables the successful post-graduate student to practice periodontics and implant dentistry at the specialist level.



#### Calendar

The academic year starts on mid-September and runs until end of June. The student admission procedure is based on a selection examination consisting of an interview, a written test in periodontology with a multiple choice questions at an undergraduate level and a written test in professional English. The program includes at least 5 sessions of 3-4 hours per week treating patients, seminars (lectures, literature reviews, case presentations), one session of instruction time to undergraduate students and 8 hours per week dedicated to a research project.

### Research project

During the 3-year course, each student will carry out a research project. The project could be either in basic sciences related to periodontology or a clinical research project. The students will be exposed to the research projects going on in the department and they will have to choose their own topic. The project has to be completed and a written report presented to the director prior to the student graduation.

## Clinical performance

During the program, the students are required to complete at least:

- -25 periodontal cases which included surgical procedures, prosthetic and/or orthodontic treatment, implant placements
- -at least 100 surgical procedures (not including implants)
- -at least 20 implants including surgical and prosthetic procedures
