At the same time there will be a beautiful **Congress reserved for Dental Hygienists** which, thanks to extraordinary Speakers, will constitute a journey into the complex problems of the aging patient, with the implications of systemic health, maintenance of motivation and all their periodontal and implant consequences.

The Saturday afternoon **After Congress** will continue to be a unique event, with a Training camp for Dentistry Student Members who were already AISO Members and three theoretical courses held by super Experts.

I'm sure they will be three wonderful days, in which we will be able to interact with the greatest minds and ask questions and find answers, but more than anything else, nourish enthusiasm and passion for our beautiful profession.
