
We will examine how scientific evidence supports essentiality, and how innovation can align with a more natural, uncomplicated vision - enhancing what already works.

How to get to Rimini

By plane The nearest airport is Federico Fellini International Airport (RMI) in Rimini. However, Rimini is also accessible from nearby airport in Bologna (Guglielmo Marconi Airport) which is approximately 100 km from Rimini by motorway.

Bologna International Airport has daily connections with all the major Italian, European, and International cities throughout the world and is served by all the major airlines. A shuttle bus service operates between Bologna's International Airport and the city of Rimini:

Shuttle Italy Airport

Guglielmo Marconi International Airport is located just a few minutes from the main railway station Stazione Centrale served by taxi and train. You can get a taxi from the airport on the ground floor, just outside the door of

the landing area (the cost of a taxi from the airport to Stazione Centrale in Bologna is about 20/30€).

You can get "People mover" the brand-new high-speed train that takes only 7 minutes to arrive at Stazione Centrale train station. A train every 7 minutes. The price of a single ticket is 12,80€ (one way) or 23,3€ (return).

The average train time from Bologna Stazione Centrale to Rimini is 1h 4m, although it takes just 53m on the fastest high-speed Frecciarossa and Frecciargento services.

By train A good railway network connects Rimini to the rest of Italy. As above, you can easily reach Bologna in an hour, and by high-speed connections, Milan in 2 hours, Florence in 2,30 hours and Rome in less than 4.

By car Rimini is well connected with the rest of Italy, thanks to a very good motorway network. The city is positioned along the A14 motorway which connects it to Bologna and Milan going North and to Bari going South.
